Numerous adventure stations on 1,500 m² in the indoor area, a large children's playground in the grounds, an inviting restaurant with 100 seats indoors and 400 more on the terrace as well as a self-service café in the park expand the unique world of experience at Minimundus.

Minimundus is the ideal destination for a day trip, nestled between the picturesque Europa Park in the immediate vicinity of Lake Wörthersee and the enchanting city of Klagenfurt. Located directly at the A2 motorway exit, with sufficient parking spaces in front of the entrance, Minimundus invites you on a journey around the world in miniature.

The trip around the world begins in the well-kept miniature park, where you can marvel at the models built to a scale of 1:25 and based on real plans and using original materials. Since 2016, the journey around the world has been continued interactively in the indoor world of experience. With various playful stations, a world of experience and information was created for the guests, which contains topics for adults as well as entertainment for children and young people. Special attractions are undoubtedly the 4D cinema, the live stream from the International Space Station (ISS) and a model railway with historical train sets.

The unique view of the Statue of Liberty, the Eiffel Tower or the Sagrada Familia make lunch, dinner and a small snack a real pleasure. Austrian coffee house culture awaits on the sun terrace with a wonderful view of the park, and you can also enjoy ice cream creations and homemade pastries.
